1. Sand work to 220.
2. Lightly spray 1-2 coats of sanding sealer, rattle can.
3. After it cures, sand starting at 220 (or 150), to 320.
4. Lightly spray 1-2 coats of finish (lacquer/poly).
5. Sand.... 220-400
6. Repeat steps 4, 5, increasingly finer grits, up to 14 coats, until your finish is consistent and where you want it.
