The math is $7 \div 1.618 = 4.33$. if you are doing a simple chalice with a no thrills stem there are three primary details that require the calculation: the cup OD, the cup length, the cup base. The cup OD and base OD follow the same calculation as the bowl example. The cup length/depth is the overall chalice length divided by 1.618. The same principles follow for a finial on a vessel. The finial height is determined by the vessel height either multiplied or divided [as either works perfectly]. If the vessel is 5" tall, then the finial is either $5 \div 1.618$ or its 5 times 1.618.
