I've personally done the test with a glue joint using titebond III. The wood broke, not the glue.

The paper joint is there to introduce a weak point so when you split the joint later, the paper gives way rather than the wood splitting. The paper joint is strong enough because it's over a relatively large area

the wood breaks on 200yr old hide glue

From sheila white (Chatham, ON) :
use the same glue/paper method for inside out turning. I was skeptical at first too, so also used hose clamps

crazy....just like a weld is stronger than the two pieces of metal and the metal usually fails not the weld....welder dependent of course
