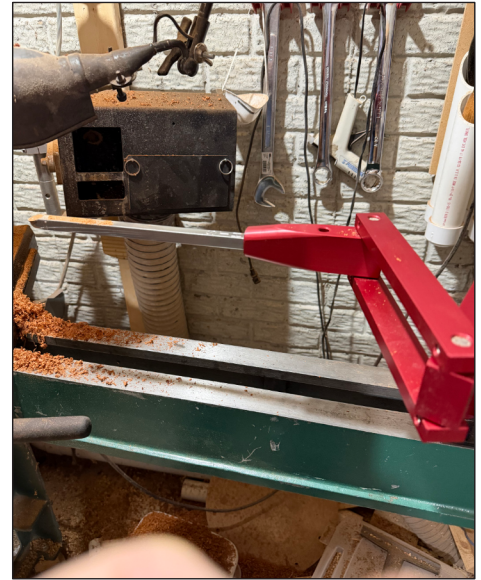

The system holds carbide cutters and allows the user to continue turning even when holding traditional tools becomes difficult.
